SUMMER SCHOOL ENROLLMENT

Counselors have a March 29th deadline to register students for summer school. We will not be able to access summer school enrollment again until later in May. We have automatically enrolled students who have D/F semester grades, but there are other summer school opportunities such as taking Spanish or Integrated Math I, II, or II to get ahead. FINANCIAL AID APPLICATIONS

April 2nd is the deadline for seniors to submit their financial aid applications, which is during Spring break. Seniors can see their counselor before the break if they need help. Once students have submitted their application, the next step is to create an account on the California Student Aid Commission website called WebGrants 4 Students https://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov/ where they can see what grants they qualify for and how to manage them. Seniors need to know their SSN or California Dream Act ID for this step.
