According to this feedback, there is a community desire for a public multi-purpose center, and the County of San Diego has developed a design plan for this facility to match the current and future needs of the Mira Mesa community, with options for everyone and a focus on youth.

Programming. In addition to providing a community space for teens to engage in programming after hours when schools need to close, the revitalized Epicentre will also have rooms and offerings available for the public to reserve during public hours.

Amenities. Preferred interior amenities include a lounge area, game tables and consoles, workstations, music room, fitness equipment, stage with AV equipment, demonstration kitchen, and multi-purpose space. Preferred exterior amenities include central gathering areas, open turf areas, garden areas, and sports courts.

Mira Mesa High School. In acknowledging requests for a larger arts venue in Mira Mesa, the City and County of San Diego support Mira Mesa High School's Phase 3 Site Modernization plan to build a new Performing Arts venue with over 600 seats that can be booked and utilized by the public.
