

APPLICATION TIP

Here is a college application tip for seniors applying to four-year colleges or universities. For any San Diego Unified School they attended, they input all of their classes as semester classes including the year we did online learning. Quarters 1 and 3 are equivalent to Semester 1 and Quarters 2 and 4 are equivalent to Semester 2. Seniors can avoid this common mistake by attending our college application workshops each day at lunch in the library until November 30th. If your child has application questions during the Thanksgiving break, they need to contact the office of admissions for the colleges they are applying to in order to get their questions answered.

COLLEGE CLASS REMINDER

Students who are taking a college class need to remember that D grades are equivalent to F grades on their college transcript. Having a D or F grade on a college transcript can cause your child to start college on academic probation or impact receiving financial aid. If your child is in English 101 or Political Science 102 and earn an F, they will not meet graduation requirements and will need to make up the class. Counselors will meet with these students after grades are processed to create a remediation plan. College classes will end before our winter break, which means students only have a few weeks to get their grade up to a C or better. If your child is struggling in their college class, they need to reach out to their professor to get help.

ARTICULATION

Counselors began articulation with Class of 2027 and 2026 students Thursday and Friday in their English classes. Counselors will then meet individually the students to review their progress toward graduation, discuss postsecondary plans, and their course selection. Class of 2027 will have their counselor meetings November 29th-December 4th. Class of 2026 will have their one to one meetings December 6th-11th. We will start articulation presentations with Class of 2025 students November 28th. Here are links to the presentations:

Counselors will conduct senior reviews after the break for our students who earned an F grade in a required course for the second progress report or are not on track to earn a diploma this June. They will sign a letter that will be mailed and emailed.
