I would like to send a BIG CONGRATULATIONS to the Boys Wrestling team for winning the CIF Division 2 Championship last Saturday. This is the first time the team has won CIF since 2014 and "Mira Mesa claimed the team title with 214 points. Mira Mesa sent six wrestlers to championship matches, leading all schools. The Marauders turned those six finalists into three individual championships. Sophomore Aden Vang and juniors Jeremy Tajiri and Sardor Usmonov all won medals." (*Quotes from the 2.11.24 Union Tribune*) The Boys and Girls Wrestling team will compete on Friday and Saturday this week at CIF Masters where individuals compete for the opportunity to go to the State Championships February 22-24 in Bakersfield.

The Boys and Girls Basketball teams began CIF play this week as well. The girls are the number 3 seed while the boys are the number 4 seed, both in Division 3. Both teams won in the first round and will continue to host in round two. Girls play Friday night at 7PM and boys play Saturday night, game time TBD. We hope to see you at the game to support our amazing Marauder student-athletes.

If you are 9th-11th grade student planning to take any college classes for the first time next year, you need to complete several steps for enrollment. The district is already emailing students prompting them to complete their Miramar enrollment. You should be regularly checking your emails, both district and personal, for messages from Jeffrey Thomas, one of our district coordinators, and following his instructions. Students must complete the enrollment process by the end of February. If you are currently taking CCAP classes, you do not need to complete the registration steps again. 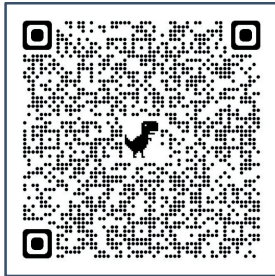
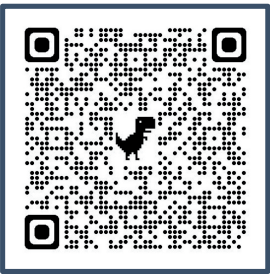
