Principal's Message

Good Afternoon, Marauders.

URGENT: Please review this drop-off/pick-up information and share with your friends/family. We don't want to close off the lot, but we may have to if the heavy drop-off/pick-up traffic continues.

Please do not drop-off/pick-up in the small lot near the flag pole/office. The lanes need to be kept clear so students and staff with disabilities/injuries can access the accessible routes, for emergency response vehicles to access campus, and for those going to the office for appointments/meetings. Do not park in the red zone or along the blue fence line. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work through this construction project.


